Position:	Journeyman Electrician

Position Purpose:

Complete all electrical work in a code compliant manner while allocating work to apprentices in order to effectively complete projects. Duties includes overseeing work completed by apprentice's, proper installation of residential and/or commercial electrical systems, and communicating with administration as well as customers.

Essential Job Functions:

- Performing General Physical Activities including handling and moving objects in excess of 50 lbs.
- Ensure work sites are clean. Dig holes or trenches. Move construction or extraction materials to locations where they are needed.
- Assemble equipment and structures.
- Cut and/or bend metal components for installation.
- Drill holes in construction materials.
- Install electrical components, equipment, or systems in accordance to National Electrical Codes.
- Thread wire or cable through ducts or conduits.
- Monitor Processes, Materials, or Surroundings.
- Updating and Using Relevant Knowledge.
- Inspect electrical or electronic systems for defects. Test electrical equipment or systems to ensure proper functioning.
- Establish and maintain interpersonal relationships while communicating with Supervisors, Peers, or Subordinates.
- Repairing and Maintaining Electronic Equipment.
- Making Decisions and Solving Problems.
- Evaluating Information to Determine Compliance with Standards.
- Operating Vehicles, Mechanized Devices, or Equipment.
- Effectively lead apprentices through projects as well as collaborate with fellow Journeyman.

KNOWLEDGE REQUIREMENTS:

- English Language Knowledge of the structure and content of the English language including the meaning and spelling of words, rules of composition, and grammar.
- **Mechanical** Knowledge of machines and tools, including their designs, uses, repair, and maintenance.
- **Electrical** Knowledge of electrical systems and installation processes including proper procedures and current National Electrical Code standards.



- **Building and Construction** Knowledge of materials, methods, and the tools involved in the construction or repair of houses, buildings, or other structures such as highways and roads.
- Customer and Personal Service Knowledge of principles and processes for providing customer and personal services. This includes customer needs assessment, meeting quality standards for services, and evaluation of customer satisfaction.

WORK ENVIRONMENT:

Most job duties are performed in the field (project sites including a customer's home and/or building construction sites).

- ➤ **Body Positioning -** Requires bending or twisting. Requires climbing ladders, scaffolds, or poles. Requires walking and running. Requires repetitive movement. Requires standing for long periods of time. Requires using hands to handle, control, or feel objects, tools or controls. Requires kneeling, crouching, stooping or crawling. Requires getting into and working in cramped work spaces.
- Communication Requires contact with others (face-to-face, by telephone, or otherwise). Requires face-to-face discussions with individuals or teams.
- ➤ Impact of Decisions Requires making decisions that impact the results of coworkers, clients or the company. Mistakes are not easily correctable and have serious consequences. Requires making decisions that affect other people, the financial resources, and/or the image and reputation of the organization. Requires making decisions without supervision.
- ➤ **Job Hazards -** Requires exposure to minor burns, cuts, bites, or stings. Requires exposure to hazardous equipment. Requires exposure to hazardous conditions. Requires exposure to high places.
- ➤ Level of Challenge Requires repeating the same physical activities or mental activities. Requires being exact or highly accurate.
- ➤ **Responsibility for Others -** Includes responsibility for the health and safety of others. Requires responsibility for ensuring apprentices are doing assigned work properly.
- ➤ Work Attire Requires wearing common protective or safety equipment as well as professional work attire.
- ➤ Work Setting Job tasks are performed in close physical proximity to other people. Requires working outdoors, exposed to all weather conditions. Requires working indoors in non-controlled and controlled environments.
